As a result of the IT Optimization program, Ohio has:

- Saved over \$120M since January 2013
- “Flipped” IT spending from being 80% infrastructure and 20% application-focused to currently 50% infrastructure and 50% applications
- Migrated over 120+ agencies into a unified structure and operating model
- Remediated the State of Ohio Computer Center, which is now ranked as one of the top 10 data centers in the nation.
