Duties

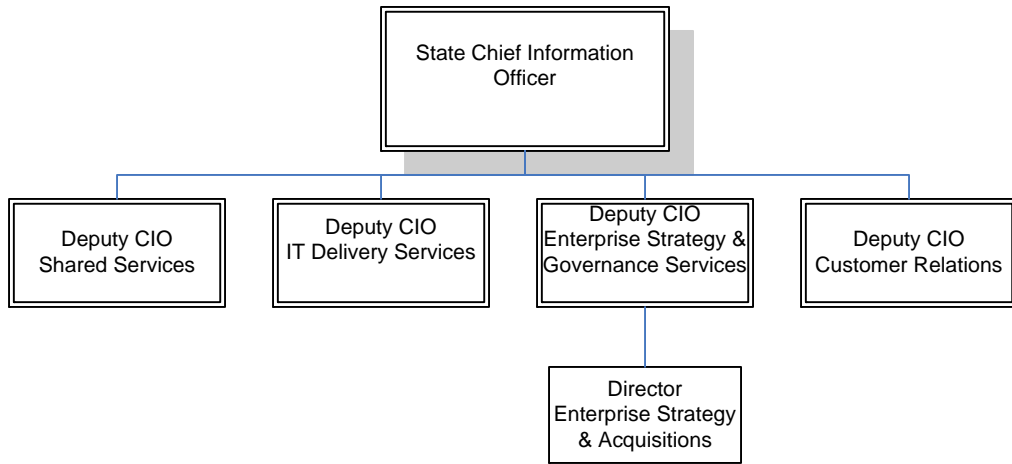
Under the general direction of the New York State Deputy Chief Information Officer for Enterprise Strategy & Governance, the Director functions as the director of the Enterprise Strategy & Acquisitions program area and is responsible for developing, staffing, and managing the area. Significant high-level interaction with the Division of the Budget, relating to all agencies' compliance with the annual technology plan and intent to purchase requirements, and the Chief Information Officers of all agencies on procurements, policies, standards and methodologies handled by the unit are critical components for successful performance. The Director works with wide latitude and independence in establishing and overseeing the program area to:

- Coordinate Annual Technology Planning process and development of the NYS Enterprise Technology Plan;
- Coordinate the development and promulgation of enterprise information technology (IT) policies;
- Coordinate the development and promulgation of enterprise information technology standards; and
- Coordinate the development and establishment of Enterprise Licensing agreements to reflect technology standards
- Oversee the operation of the IT Staff Augmentation initiative

The Director helps ensure that the NYS Chief Information Officer/Office for Technology (CIO/OFT) works to elevate an understanding of technology as a tool in an enterprise-wide approach to management and decision-making and helps change the paradigm of central service delivery in government to one of facilitation and guidance. The Director develops, deploys, and manages the State's Enterprise Strategic IT plans by incorporating best practices, guidelines, and tools to ensure strategic goals are achieved and to provide a competitive advantage for the State.

Illustrative duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Manages work, staff and work relationships, including the critical relationships with the CIO Council, agencies' IT managers, the Division of the Budget, and stakeholders.
- Develops, approves, implements, and modifies uniform policies, standards, practices, and procedures to simplify internal and interagency preparation of strategic and Annual Technology Plans (ATPs) and Plan to Procure (PTP); provides uniform documents; and integrates multiple plans and purchases into consolidated categories.
- Assists the Deputy CIO in coordinating the development and promulgation of IT policies.
- Manages the IT governance program to optimize IT investments.
- Coordinates and manages other strategic planning activities through the CIO/OFT and State Enterprise.
