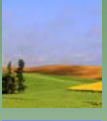

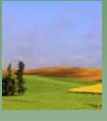

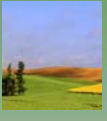
Governance and Accountability

- Architecture is adopted by the Information Services Board with representatives from state government, private sector, and multiple agencies
- The Information Services Board chartered the Enterprise Architecture Committee to develop and propose enterprise architecture policies and standards for adoption
- The architecture will increase the efficiency and effectiveness of information technology service delivery



Framework and Approach

- Framework is based on NASCIO Enterprise Toolkit
- Policies and standards are developed:
 - Through collaborative, multi-agency teams
 - Using business, information, technology, and solution architectures



Status of Architecture

- Completed January 2007
 - Integration architecture standards
 - Networking standards
 - Voice over Internet protocol guidelines
 - Justice information XML standards
 - Project 25 radio interoperability standards

- Currently Underway
 - Common Services for Service Oriented Architecture
 - Identity Management
