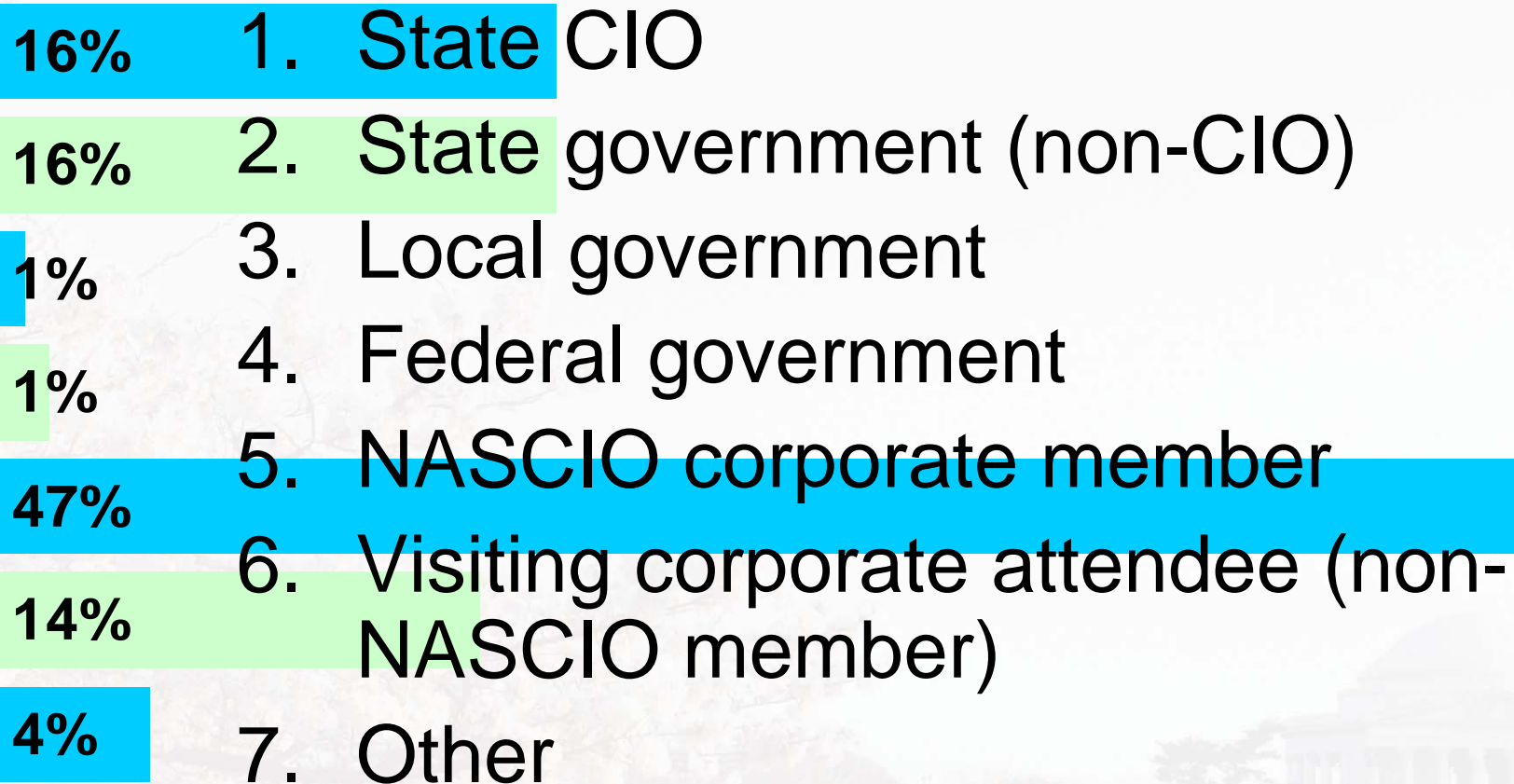


Who are you?
