



Working 4 Utah: The 4 Day Work Week

In June 2008, Governor Jon Huntsman announced that Utah would implement a mandatory 4-day work week for state government creating ripples way beyond the State's borders.

- Utah's robust online service offerings provided the support necessary for such a significant change
- The initiative is effective because it reduces energy consumption while still providing a high level of service even while 18,000 state employees are not working.





Energy Saving Management: Changing the Way We Do Things

- State facility energy cost reduction (\$3 million)
- State of Utah now offers over 850 online services, with a significant increase in adoption rates
- Reduced carbon footprint
 - Reduction in miles driven by citizens and businesses to government offices
 - Fewer employee commutes
- Reduced processing costs for agencies
- Employees use less leave
- Time savings for citizens and government
